#### **10. Highway Matters**

- a) Bryn Posteg Landfill Site Tylwch – Clerk was requested to write to Robin Wynne Williams confirming that Llangurig Community Council object fully to the conditions being lifted.
- b) Caen Coed subsidence will be dealt with within the next few months.
- c) Blocked drain at The Bluebell Llangurig is situated in the side road opposite Church House – not on the trunk road.
- d) Cllr G Jones monitoring Maesmawr - water running off down track, needs to be tarmacked by culvert (Council road).
- e) Cllr G Jones to deal with issue of railway rank raised a couple of months ago – no one has been out to look at the problem.
- f) Correspondence from PHA Comms dated 8 December 2016 regarding Proposed Base Station Installation at ESN5036/75275 A44 Eisteddfa Gurig was discussed. It was understood that the network had got coverage for network services (near the Elvis stone). Cllr G Jones to meet with LDP Team early in 2017.
