

A meeting of Llangurig Community Council was held on Monday 14 March 2016 at the Church House Llangurig. Councillors present were Cllr Laurie Higgitt (Vice Chair) Cllrs I Bound, G Jones, J Lewis, P Windsor and R Williams.

1. **Apologies** – were received from Cllrs C Davies, M Bound, B Jones, P Jones.
2. **Declarations of Interest** – there were no Declarations of Interest.
3. **Minutes** of the meeting of 15 February 2016 were proposed by Cllr I Bound and seconded by Cllr P Windsor after the correction to 10 a) should have read Brook Cottage not Brick Cottage.
4. **Matters Arising** –

Page 3 – Residents and Visitors – local amenities, shops, B&B's, businesses, pubs, tie in with Elan Valley and Visitor attractions. Police, Hospitals, Doctors.  
Notice Board – Cllr L Higgitt to liaise with Roger Malvern.
