

A meeting of the Llangurig Community Council was held on 23 November 2015 at 7.30 p.m. in the Church House. Councillors present were C C Davies (chair) I Bound, L Higgitt, J Lewis, B Jones, R Williams and P Windsor.

1. Apologies for absence were received from Cllrs I Bound, B Jones and G Jones.
2. Declarations of Interest – there were no declarations of interest.
