

**Llangurig Community Council**  
**Remote Meeting Minutes**  
**Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2020**

Minutes of meeting held remotely via Zoom on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> October 2020 at 7.30pm.

1. **Apologies:** Cllr M Bound.
2. **Declarations of interest** *whether likely to benefit or disadvantage, should be disclosed prior to commencement of discussion.*  
No declarations of interest were made.
3. **Minutes** for meeting of 15th September 2020 were agreed and proposed as an accurate record by Cllr L Higgitt and seconded by Cllr R Williams.
4. **Highway Matters:**
  - a) **Roadway requiring a barrier following tree removal** waiting for an update on this from Highways as they were due to inspect but this had to be cancelled.
  - b) **Lights at Village Car Park** PCC lighting are sending someone out to take a look and arrange repairs if required.
  - c) **Sign to phone box for removal** Clerk is still chasing the TRA for an update as to when this will be done.
  - d) **Issues with culvert** Reported to PCC, who will inspect, no further updates at this time.
  - e) **Layby on A470 between Llanidloes and Llangurig** Reported to PCC, no response received as yet.
5. **Matters Arising:**
  - a) **Village Green; Fence and boundary issue** Boundary – solicitor had not heard from Curig Charity last time he was in touch. Someone from Curig Charity has been contacted and asked to contact the solicitor. Fence – waiting for this to be installed
  - b) **Village Play Area** waiting for the land owners' decision
  - c) **Tree Management** tree surgeon has suggested the trees are removed due to ash dieback. Insurance has clarified that the Council must do as much as possible to prevent any accidents.
  - d) **Street lighting shields** no updates
  - e) **Slates at Black Lion** no change, barriers are still up awaiting repairs to be undertaken.
  - f) **Community Wind Farm Fund** County Cllr Phyl Davies has confirmed that the fund has been set up but the accounts etc are not finalised yet.
  - g) **PCC Town & Community Council remote meeting report** This was another useful meeting clarifying the impact of covid and what will be done to help those who are struggling due to it.

Bills to be paid were agreed and proposed for payment by Cllr I Bound and seconded by Cllr C Howells.


**9. Councillors Comments:**
