

A meeting of Llangurig Community Council was held on Monday 16 May 2016 at the Church House Llangurig. Councillors present were Cllr C C Davies (Chair) Cllrs I Bound, M Bound, L Higgitt, G Jones, P Jones, J Lewis, P Windsor and R Williams.

PC8144 Geraldine Jones was in attendance and the following issues were discussed –

- a) Speed Watch – up and running in Llandinum and flashing 30 mph sign in Llangurig.
- b) Cefn Road sign – Cllr G Jones liaised with Adrian Jervis – nothing reported to the Police.
- c) Glansevern road works 30 mph – Cllr G Jones agreed to speak to Andrew Jones requesting 30 mph should be extended now that work is finished.
- d) Lane passing railway rank toward Cwm – repair entered on capital works programme.
- e) Approach down into car park – barbed wire to be removed off fence; markers, posts and rail to be erected. General tidy up required.

**1. Apologies** – were received from Cllr B Jones

- c) Paperless Planning – Clerk to contact Planning Officer advising no internet facilities in Church House or photocopier to provide plans etc., Request that paper copies be provided for the next six months.
