**10. Highway Matters**

a) Glansevern 30 mph roadworks – it was reported that Cllr G Jones had spoken recently with PC8144 Geraldine Jones who had been informed that the 30 mph restriction was a temporary measure. The members requested the Clerk to contact Russell George AM to enlist his support to clarify the matter and to ascertain when the restriction will be removed. .

b) Constituent John Dory had raised the issue concerning the fact that fire engines do not at present have access due to cars being parked at Brook Cottage. Suggested that support be requested from the Emergency Services. Recommended that this issue be raised at the next meeting as Cllr G Jones is a member of the Mid & West Wales Fire Committee.

c) Road from Llwyn Celyn to Maes Mawr needs permanent attention. The road is sinking where it has cracked and layers of tarmac is causing weight to push down where it is soft underneath. The problem is not being solved.
